### SCOUT DOINGS

Mount Stuart scouts, Lucy Bain, Isaac Beswick, John Dewis, Sarah Howells and Chris Ballard, (one of their leaders), recently attended the 22<sup>nd</sup> Australian Jamboree at Cataract Scout Park near Sydney. For eleven days the Jamboree site hosted 13,000 scouts and leaders from around Australia and overseas, most of whom were girls and boys aged 11 to 15. With a theme of 'Test your limits', activities included a commando course, rock concerts, video making, bush navigation, visiting a theme park, circus skills and much more.

The Jamboree had its own hospital, police station, fire service, internet cafes, and newspaper, TV and radio stations. The Tasmanian contingent also toured Canberra on the return journey.
